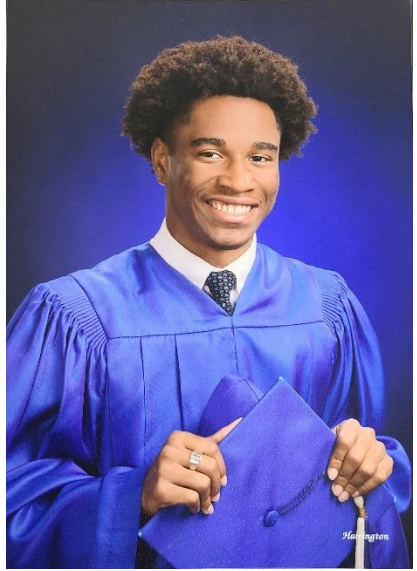

Caddo Parish Magnet High School

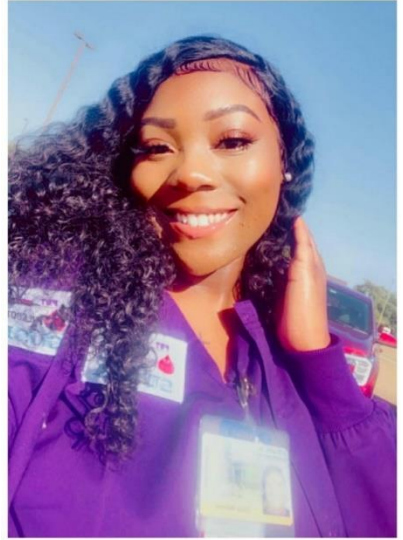

Louisiana State University-Shreveport

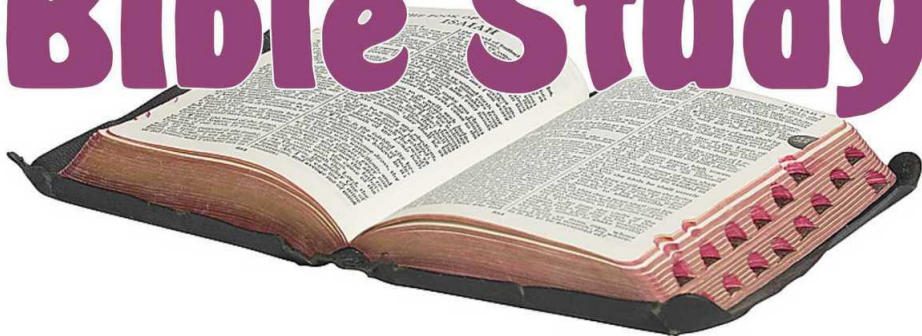
